

Scott Hunter– One Day Abstract Water Media Workshop Saturday, June 22, 2024, 9:30 – 4:00

Pittsburgh Watercolor Society is delighted to present a one day, Saturday, Abstract Water Media Workshop with instructor Scott Hunter. A 1993 graduate of Boston University, Scott studied painting and art history through a classically structured education with intensive studio training and drawing from life. His related experiences include theatrical set design, illustration, and completing commissions for wall murals and portraits. His work is part of many international collections. Scott merges his love of abstract expressionism with figuration, completing two distinct bodies of work. His work evokes specific places or memories that resonate with emotional presence.

<u>Scott's instruction for this workshop will focus</u> <u>exclusively on his abstract painting techniques</u>, and these questions will be addressed: *Why paint non-objectively? What makes an abstract painting good? Can anybody paint abstractly?* Participants will use different materials, tools, surfaces, and textures as they learn to embolden their use of color and develop the language of mark making. It is expected that all will leave the workshop with fresh ideas on how to ignite their own painting practices. Every skill level is welcome but some familiarity with use of water media is expected.
