As we continue to adapt and adjust to these uncertain times, we continue to evaluate our planned programming and find some more creative options for sharing your wonderful works with members and the public. With this in mind, we are presenting you with a new way to exhibit with ***New Works in the Time of Corona... A Virtual Exhibit.***

Amid the uncertainty presented to us, there is one continuous and comforting fact: artists don't stop making art. As you have seen, Museums and galleries may be closed but online there are "tours" of museums from Google and other sites, free lessons and live streaming demonstrations are all readily available. Taking this as our guide we have created a 75th Anniversary special exhibit through our website.

You are all invited to participate. Artists may enter one to three pieces of new work, created since the "Stay in Place" order on March 15. There is no entry fee. Works can be for sale, with the full sale price going to the artist. Note that pieces in this exhibit are NOT precluded from being entered in Aqueous.

ELIGIBILITY: this exhibit is open to PWS Juried members only, working primarily with water-based media on a paper surface (YUPO and Tyvek are permitted) and unvarnished. No canvas. Mediums include: watercolor, acrylic, casein, gouache, and egg tempura. No pastels, class work, digital images, any form of print or reproductions, 10% collage only.

Each PWS member may exhibit up to three (3) any size. Work must be completed between March 15 and May 15, 2020. No 3D work or multiple panel entries will be accepted.



NO ENTRY FEE!

All Sales Inquiries will go directly to the artist, and the full sale price goes to the artist. Artists are also responsible for arranging for delivery or pick up of the actual work and handling sales tax.

AWARDS: There will be only one award, People's Choice. Artists and guests will be able to vote via our website.

ENTRIES: Good quality images less than 1 MB in size, no mats or frames included and not shot through glass.

Image files must be named using this format: lastname_firstinitial title.jpg (or jpeg, gif, png or tif). (This allows us to manage the entries on the back end file system.)

Images must have a caption added that includes this information in this order:

Artist's name
Piece title
Piece size without frame
Price or NFS
Any other relevant information
