

John Salminen is a signature member of numerous prestigious art societies in the United States, China, and Australia, and has won over 240 awards in national and international competitions, including multiple top awards in AWS, NWS, TWSA and Allied Artists of America. He received the Shanghai Biennial Award, the Pakistan Lifetime Achievement Award and the Thailand Ministry of Culture Award. In addition, he has participated in invitational international exhibitions in China, Taiwan, Singapore, Thailand, Turkey, Russia, Greece, Mexico, Pakistan, Canada, Italy, England, Belgium, and Australia. John is a frequent judge and juror for national and international exhibitions. His work is included in permanent collections in the United States, Asia, and Europe. His work is featured in forty-two books.
